

## Thorsten Wetzling, Non-Resident Fellow

Dr. Thorsten Wetzling works as Senior Research Fellow at the Brandenburg Institute for Society and Security (BIGS) in Potsdam. He currently directs a capacity-building initiative for European civil security research funded by the German Ministry of Research and Education. Thorsten Wetzling holds a doctorate degree (magna cum laude) in political science from the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies in Geneva. Thorsten is particularly interested in the institutions, norms and administration of European and North American intelligence governance as well as the practice and reform of contemporary accountability mechanisms.

Before coming to Potsdam in September 2013, Thorsten worked as Senior Fellow at The Hague Institute for Global Justice and Advisor for the Geneva Centre for the Democratic Control of Armed Forces (DCAF) on various projects related to data privacy in transatlantic relations, civil-military affairs and security sector governance in Morocco and Tunisia. From 2009 until 2011, Thorsten was a Transatlantic Post-Doctoral Fellow for International Relations and Security (TAPIR) working at the Center for Transatlantic Relations at Johns Hopkins University in Washington, D.C., the French Institute for International Relations (ifri) in Paris and the RAND Corporation in Arlington, VA.
